

## USE OF FLAMMABLE PAINTS AND VARNISHES WITH AIRBRUSH

### ADDITIONAL CLAUSE

In consideration that the fixed rates have not been increased to cover the insured property, even though the Insured uses flammable paintings and varnishes with airbrush in his processes, the Insured is obliged to comply with the following obligations. It is heretofore understood that any change that implies an increase of hazard shall be notified to the Company within the following 24 (twenty hours), with the purpose of effecting the corresponding modifications.

**OBLIGATIONS.-** The Insured undertakes to comply with the following:

1. Works should be carried out taking all security measures, whether working outdoors or under lean-tos, having at least one side completely uncovered, without wall; contrary to such, it shall be necessary to designate a fireproof room of solid construction to paint, strip or carry out any other process related to paint or airbrush.

It is understood and agreed upon that liquid paint, solvents, dilutings and essences that are in such room shall be that kept for and used in one working day. In such room, an efficient ventilation system should function for expulsing gases out into the open. Such system shall include vents in the walls at the floor level.

2. All paints, lacquers, solvents, dilutings, essences and other necessary material for the industry shall be stored in a building or room exclusively designated for this purpose. The room should have a solid construction.
3. Smoking is forbidden and no open flame or any bare cable on light shall be used in the interior of all rooms or booths.
4. Cotton waste or similar waste shall not be left within the room or booth.
5. The engine of any vehicle in movement with its own motive power must not be allowed in such rooms or booths.
6. Any self-propelled vehicle in the process of being painted or stripped off must have the fuel tank emptied.
7. Cellulose substances handled in all rooms or booths should follow the requirements set out:
  - 7.1. No power plant or electric switchboard, transformer, engine, generator, converter, fuse switchboard, portable resistors, lamps or heaters shall be placed inside the premises.
  - 7.2. No engine, starter motor or regulator or circuit breaker shall be allowed inside the premises, unless it is hermetically sealed and it may be deemed flame and steam proof.
  - 7.3. All electric lighting shall be protected throughout by metallic "conduit" tubes, and plated at the joints.
  - 7.4. The electric lights shall be covered with gasproof glass globe or by hermetically sealed screens.
8. In all such sites where the inherent work is carried out; residues accumulating or disposable material shall be cleaned at least once a week with brushes of hard fibers (non-metallic), and the residues shall be then collected in vessels filled with water.
